The big news is that we have an heir for the cemetery – KC Noble, who attended the meeting. A letter was sent to the owner of Lot 6 to permit passage to the cemetery, but no answer yet. Don Davis is a radar tech and doesn't believe the results from the radar regarding more bodies in the cemetery. There are no marked graves in the grassy area on the south side. Radar only registers a difference in density – does not detect bodies. Only one site found was a rectangle. We need to get a dead body dowser to coordinate with the radar results if that is possible. 6th St. is a logical site for access to the cemetery.

Don asked if we make the cemetery into a historic site, can it still be used for current burials? Apparently if it is historic, it will not be for current burials. KC grew up in Guffey. He has been appointed steward of the cemetery by his father for the present time. KC is the son of David Noble of Sports Enterprise Ltd. Jon and Don have been denied access to the cemetery by the Sheriff until the owner is found – they suspect Bill Soux complained. But now, the owner has been found, and now the problem is what the best pathway to get to the cemetery is. 6th St. access is Baker's property. People have been getting to the cemetery through a path from 6th St and 7th St. Block 7 is Kirby's property. 4th was vacated in 1980. Cheryl Sandifer is the heir to the pond property (4th St.). 5th St is next to the school. There is septic stuff on block 8. We need cooperation from Baker, to go through 6th St, the most logical access.

We need to get a right of way to the property. No property should be land locked. They are trying to get right of way or easement in perpetuity. North – south streets are 70 feet wide. East – west streets are 60 feet wide.
