Meeting Minutes

**Present:** Mike Brandt, Flip Boettcher, Gail Carver

**Treasurer's Report:** Balance as of 03/01/21: \$3877.53. Treasurer Mike Brandt reported that there are 35 active members. Mike reported that Park County needs to come down to the Community Center building to activate new codes in case we have additional, new members.

**Discussion:**

Community news: Flip reported that the new owners of the building that previously housed the Rolling Thunder Cloud Café, was sold to Mike and Kate from Grand Junction. They hope to open a distillery in the building sometime this year. Flip wrote a Farewell to the Café article in the Flume, when Wayne and Geordi Walston closed the café late last year.

Improvements: Mike Brandt reported that Park County had installed a generator for the Community Center building, to be available in case of a power outage when the building might be required to house people in an emergency.

Vaccine Clinic: Mike Brandt also reported that the Southern Park County Fire District station here in Guffey is trying to coordinate a vaccine clinic at the station.

Guffey Shares: The topic of reactivating the Guffey Share email list was discussed at length. The owner of The Bakery, Dana Peters, is eager to have a means of communicating with locals to grow her bakery/restaurant business. Dana has volunteered to moderate the existing Guffey Shares list if we reactivate it. It was proposed that we seek input from the current email recipients to confirm there was interest in it being reactivated. Gail Carver proposed that the board send an email to everyone on the list to ask for feedback and she volunteered to write the email and gain everyone's approval. It was also suggested that the board seek new moderators to manage the email list who would remain anonymous.

Upcoming events in 2021: As the Covid pandemic wanes, we are hearing of some annual events being scheduled in 2021. The Fire Station hopes to have their annual Fire Sale during Labor Day weekend. It is unknown if there will be a Steampunk Festival or Car Show.
